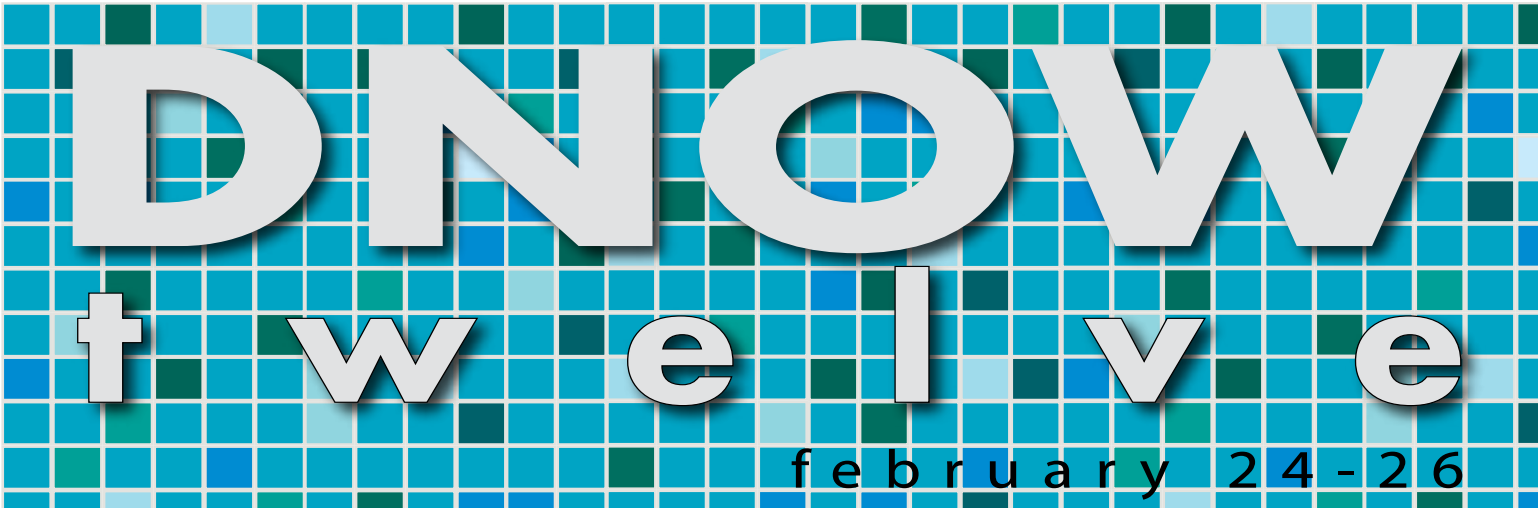

DNOW Guidelines
